Sacred Space

Reflections on St John 2. 1 (Marriage at Cana)

This is the first miracle performed by Jesus. Scholars have identified the symbolism of Jesus turning the water used for Jewish purification rites into wine as significant. Perhaps the writer of John was trying to make the connection between the blood of the new covenant, which was part of Christian worship by the time John's Gospel was written, and wine.

Perhaps the one sure thing we can get from the author is that the faith of the disciples was greatly impacted by this event. "Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him."

It is the story of the start of our Lord's signs that he is the Christ. It is the start of the belief of his disciples. It is the start of our story of transformation as well.

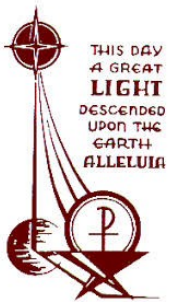
